We expect all our volunteers to believe in Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

Side Kick: partner with a sailor (a cool kid who happens to have a disability). Commitment to, at least, each Tuesday for one month.

Welcome Greeters/Security: greet sailors as they arrive and help with name tags as needed. Move to help with other areas, such as snack clean up. Check kids out at 5:30, check ID of parent/person picking up the kid and make sure they are signed out. Commitment one month at a time or at least one Tuesday a month.

Story Teller: Tell an engaging story (Youth Friendship Materials are purchased and have the lesson prepared). You will be responsible for finding props you may want to use, the church has a large selection of items from which to use. The lesson comes with some posters and other items for you to use. Estimated story length...10 minutes. Commitment one month at a time, or at least one Tuesday each month.

Crafts: Planning and preparing the needed items. Lead the students during the craft time. Clean up. Have fun! Commitment one month at a time or at least one Tuesday a month.

Worship Leader: Lead the kids in engaging music with motions. It would be awesome if some of the kids could help with the music. Commitment one month at a time, or at least one Tuesday a month.

Snack Leader: Prepare and bring healthy snacks for the sailors. Snacks could go along with our friendship lesson and the kids could get involved. Commitment one month at a time, or at least one Tuesday a month.
